- 2. The internship offer letter from employer must:
 - a. Be printed on the company letterhead and signed by a company representative
 - b. Show clearly the start and end dates of employment (These dates must fall within the start and end dates of the semester)
 - c. Show clearly the number of hours the student should work per week (minimum of 150 hours)
 - i. ≤ 20 hours during Fall and Spring semester
 - ii. ≤ 35 hours during the summer or winter break
 - d. Name of student's direct supervisor be printed on the letter; and
 - e. Have detailed job responsibilities of the intern
- 3. International students fill out 'Student Request Form' in the CPT application form and show to academic advisor along with your internship offer letter.

- 4. Academic advisor will request Department Chair/Director of Experiential Education to approve internship. International students need 'Department Chair Approval Form' (third page in CPT application form);
- 5. Once approved by the Director of Experiential Education, register for Zero credit Internship course (BUSIE 290/BUSIE 650) or 3 credit internship course with your academic advisor, who will notify Department Chair & Director of Experiential Education to create this 3 credit course;
- 6. International students, after registering for the course, should go to Office of International Education and get I-20 form updated; and
