How To Properly Clean and Disinfect IT Equipment:

Question:

What can I use to sanitize and disinfect computers and other equipment for the coronavirus?



Answer:

To **Disinfect** a Laptop, Keyboard, Printer, Phone or other equipment, you can safely use the Clorox wipes in the **YELLOW** tubs.



If you can't find any Clorox Disinfecting Wipes, you can also use a solution of 70 percent isopropyl alcohol and 30 water, as recommended by the CDC.

Mix a solution that is 70 percent alcohol and 30 percent water and put it in a spray bottle. Spritz a disposable cloth with the solution – **not the equipment**.



PLEASE NOTE

- Many household cleaners and disinfectants have bleach, peroxides, acetone, or ammonia, which may cause permanent damage to the product.
- Do not use aerosol sprays or abrasives.
- Do not spray cleaners directly onto the item.
- Avoid abrasive cloths
- Turn off the device before cleaning and clean all surfaces that hands may touch.
