- OMITTING INFORMATION (DATES, DETAILS)
 - INCLUDE INFORMATION FROM COLLEGE THROUGH MEDICAL SCHOOL – IN <u>ALL</u> APPLICABLE CATEGORIES (I.E., WORK EXPERIENCE, RESEARCH EXPERIENCE, HONORS, ACTIVITIES, AFFILIATIONS, COMMUNITY SERVICE)
 - The <u>only</u> reason to leave a heading OUT is if you have <u>nothing</u> related to it. Otherwise, "fill" all sections to ensure it is complete.
- NOT PLACING ITEMS IN *Reverse* CHRONOLOGICAL ORDER.
- NOT SEPARATING INFORMATION INTO SUB-HEADINGS.
- NOT BEING CONSISTENT IN FORMATTING, FONT STYLE, AND SIZE.
- NOT SPELL-CHECKING AND PROOF-READING TO FIND ERRORS.
